Math:

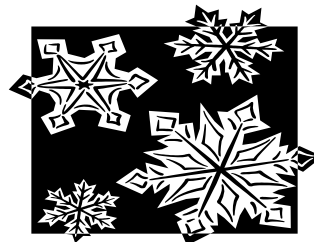
Visual awareness of the difference with the double digit number "10"
