Thank you for choosing Bethany Busy Bee Preschool for your child! We hope you've had a wonderful summer, and are refreshed and excited to be starting school.

The teachers have had such fun visiting with you and your children over the last few weeks. Thank you for welcoming them into your homes! This little visit sets the stage as they discern how best to serve your child and to establish their plans for the fall. As measured by TS Gold, this past year all of our children met, but 71% to 92% of our students **exceeded** widely held expectations for growth in social-emotional skills, language, cognitive and physical development, literacy and math.

We are also very grateful to start the year with a brand new playground and we are still waiting for some outdoor instruments to be installed, all thanks to the ECHO grant. Mr. Hasbrouck installed new automatic hands free water faucets in the bathrooms which offers a healthier way to wash our hands. And we are so grateful to be able to have our new kindergarten classroom!

In efforts to promote healthy habits, Bethany Busy Bee will be holding a Highline Canal Family Walk-a-thon on Monday, September 30th and Thursday, October 30th from 10:00 am to 11:30 am. MDO may join either day. All families, grandparents, and friends are welcome to participate. There is no need to collect donations in order to join the walk-a-thon fun but we certainly do appreciate it if you do. Bring your water bottle, your stroller, and your walking shoes and lets walk together starting from Busy Bee and ending at the "Milliken Park". Just do your shopping; give the checker your card **before they** scan any items; ask them to load your gift card using a check, cash or credit card; then, pay for your groceries using your King Soopers Gift Card. The cards are pretty easy to use and it is amazing how the \$\$ add up. Just remember to keep an amount on it at all times, otherwise it will expire if it has no balance for over 90 days.
