Each time you come to Bethany on Sunday mornings, you have the opportunity to earn Bible Bucks that you can spend at our store. The store will be open for shopping a couple of times a year, that way you have time to earn enough bucks to get something you really like. Here are the ways that you can earn bible bucks:

- Attend Sunday School = 1 bible buck
- Bring your Bible = 1 bible buck
- Bring a friend = 1 bible buck
- Participate positively in group activity = 1 bible buck
- Recite a bible verse = 1 bible buck per week; may recite same verse up to 3 weeks in a row; can be any verse, some suggestions are provided
- Recite the books of the old testament = 10 bible bucks only good 1-time
- Recite the books of the new testament = 10 bible bucks -only good 1-time
- Recite the 10 Commandments = 10 bible bucks- only good 1-time (3)
- Read a book of the bible = 10 bible bucks (discussion needed to verify)
- Recite the Lord's Prayer = 5 bible bucks

Bible bucks will be kept at church in a personalized envelope with your name on it. Each week you attend, you can place any bible bucks earned that day into your envelope for safe keeping. Bible Bucks will be awarded at the end of Sunday School hour.
