Busy Bee Enrollment for 2023-2024

To enroll, children must be between 1.6 years old and 6 years old by October 1, 2023 per Colorado regulations. Fill out the Registration Form and return it to the school office. A completed form for each child should be accompanied with your non-refundable registration fee of \$200 for one child or \$300 per family. Your child is registered, which means the spot in the classroom is secured, after the registration form and payment are re**ceived**. You will still need to complete the enrollment packet, and pay the last month's tuition by August 1st to start school. Registration is on a first come/first served basis. Please register early if you have a class preference! Forms are available up front and at the school office.

In the first few years of a child's life, parents eagerly await each milestone.

The first smile. The first step. The first words.

But some important milestones are not as obvious -- and missing them can be warning signs of developmental delays and other issues that can affect your child's ability to meet their full potential. We want every child to have a great opportunity to learn and grow— so it's important to get help when needed in the critical early school years. If you have any questions about your child's development, Littleton Public School's Child Find offers FREE screenings for children, birth to 5 years of age, who are at risk for delays. The team consists of an occupational therapist, speech and language pathologist and a school psychologist. The screening provides general information about a child's current speech/language, motor, social, and pre-academic skills. Parents can call **303-347-6980** for an appointment.

Universal Preschool the Year Before Kindergarten, UPK

UPK Registration for all children who will be 4 years old by Oct. 1, 2023 opens on Jan. 17th. You will need proof of income to complete the simple enrollment form online and be eligible for 10 to 15 hours of fully paid preschool. Please request Bethany Busy Bee as your provider, if you would like to continue at Busy Bee. Spots will be reserved for children already enrolled at Busy Bee.
