Literacy Note

Did you know that the alphabet and letter sounds aren't the only literacy skill a preschooler can learn? In fact, if you wait until your child is ready, he or she can learn their letters in just a matter of days! Instead of worrying about whether or not your child knows their letters, focus on a wide range of literacy skills like rhyming, segmenting the sounds of a word (for example, say the sounds in cat C-A-T) and blending sounds (what word do the sounds B-I-G make?)
