Handwriting

When your little one was born, he or she had close to 300 bones in their body. As they grow towards adulthood, they will have only 206 or so bones! This might sound like a really random fact to include in this newsletter, but it's important because your child's hands are not fully developed yet. This means handwriting will be difficult! Their hands have more bones than an adult hand, and the bones are more flexible. too. Instead of jumping into handwriting when your child is still young, practice skills that are precursors to it, like cutting, coloring, recognizing patterns, strenthening hand muscles through using spray bottles and playing with playdough.
