#### **Busy Bee Enrollment for 2024-2025**

To enroll, children must be between 1.6 years old and 6 years old by October 1, 2024 per Colorado regulations. Fill out the Registration Form and return it to the school office. A completed form for each child should be accompanied with your non-refundable registration fee of \$200 for one child or \$300 per family. Your child is registered, which means the spot in the classroom is secured, after the registration form and payment are received. You will still need to complete the enrollment packet, and pay the last month's tuition by August 1st to start school. Registration is on a first come/first served basis. Please register early!

#### **Child Find**

In the first few years of a child's life, parents eagerly await each milestone.

The first smile. The first step. The first words.

But some important milestones are not as obvious -- and missing them can be warning signs of developmental delays and other issues that can affect your child's ability to meet their full potential. We want every child to have a great opportunity to learn and grow— so it's important to get help when needed in the critical early school years. If you have any questions about your child's development, Littleton Public School's Child Find offers FREE screenings for children, birth to 5 years of age, who are at risk for delays. The team consists of an occupational therapist, speech and language pathologist and a school psychologist. The screening provides general information about a child's current speech/language, motor, social, and pre-academic skills. Parents can call 303-347-6980 for an appointment.

## Universal Preschool The Year Before Kindergarten, UPK

UPK registration for all children who will be 4 years old by Oct. 1, 2024, opens online in late January. You will need to complete the simple enrollment form online to be eligible for 10 to 15 hours of fully paid preschool each week.

We will save your spot, if you have already registered with us. Then, please request Bethany Busy Bee as your provider, to use the UPK funds for tuition.

Spots will be reserved for children already enrolled at Bethany Busy Bee.

#### Colorado Shines Parent Survey
