Parent Feedback: If you haven't already done so, please return your completed end of the year school evaluation form to the check in center or by email. This information is a great help to us as we plan for the future. Also, please remember that your continuous feedback is always welcome and desired as our mission is to partner with parents, and offer excellence for your children and family. In response to last year's survey, we changed drop off hours to 8:45am per survey request to drop off before 9am. We opened up the PNO special presentation to all families with a small fee to participate if the PNO is full. We will put this in practice going forward. Even if you will be returning next year, we void all the cards on the last day of school and will need the key card returned to reset it for next school year.

**Summer Camps:** If you are signed up for VBS or our Summer Programs, we'd like to have payment before graduation to help us plan for the appropriate staff. VBS elementary has openings, all others are full. You may be placed in waitlist because there are changes that occur.

2024 Fall Silent Auction: We start working on the silent auction over the summer. We will meet during the summer camps. Please take some donation request forms with you as you go out and about with your family this summer. Or help email donation requests. **2024-2025 School Year:** We praise and thank God that the school is **nearly** full for the 2024-2025 school year! However, please continue to tell your friends about Busy Bee so we can fill the **openings that remain in our MW 2** ½ class, 2½ - 5 MDO class, and Friday Toddler class for the fall.

If your child is coming back in September, please remember to return all of your paperwork (physical, immunizations, information & emergency form) along with your **May 2025 pre-paid tuition** before August 1<sup>st</sup>.
