Children must be symptom free for 24 hours before returning and participating in programs.

- Fever of 100.4 degrees or above. Child needs to be fever free for 24 hours without medication.
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- New loss of taste or smell
- Cough
- Chills
- Muscle aches
- Sore throat
- Vomiting or diarrhea
- Discharge from the nose that is yellow or green in color
- Questionable rashes
- Pink eye
- Any sign of illness
