At Home

- Help your child recognize their printed name (one capital & rest lowercase)
- Each week go on a hunt for our letters of the week, and numbers 2 & 3. Look on signs and in print items.
- Recognize a square has 4 sides that are the same length. Ask your child to find things that are the shape of a square. Practice drawing a square. What can you make from a square?
- Discuss what happens to leaves in the fall? What do you notice? Do they make a sound? How do they feel?
